

eVisa

Tanzania introduced an eVisa system on 26 November 2018. It is obligatory to have a visa to enter Tanzania unless you are from one of a few countries which are visa exempt.

When traveling to the country this normally presents you with two options. You can either enter with a prearranged Tanzania eVisa or get a visa on arrival.

Visa on arrival - All other nationalities, that are not visa exempt may obtain a visa on arrival. Visa must be paid with notes of USD50 or USD100. The length of stay is determined at ports of entry.
