

Morocco Visa requirements

Whether or not you need a visa for Morocco depends on your nationality. Citizens of several countries are exempt from Morocco visa requirements – which means they can travel to Morocco without having to obtain a visa beforehand.



In order to enter Morocco, a visitor must have the following:

A valid passport with 6 or more months before expiration.

Must have at least one blank page for the entry stamp

A return-flight ticket which is within the next 90 days

Visa not required/exempt

If you are from one of the following countries, you do not need a visa for Morocco for stays of up to 90 days (except the ones otherwise specified):

*Citizens of Hong Kong and Singapore can only stay in Morocco for up to 30 days.

Visa required

All other nationalities must have a valid visa for Morocco. These travelers cannot enter the country without a visa. Visa-required countries include most African nations, and some countries across Asia.

The eVisa fees for Morocco are as follows:

For a single entry (up to 90 days): From USD 112, EUR95, depending on your nationality

Response within 1 to 3 days

Your approved online visa for Morocco is sent to your email address in PDF format. You can then download the visa onto any mobile device and print a paper copy.

To avoid any complications, it's advisable to carry both a paper and digital copy of your visa.

You only need a few basic items to apply for the online visa. Before you can start the application process you'll need to have the following:

Passport	Email address
Residency card or visa (if applicable)*	Debit or credit card
Photograph of applicant	

Your passport must be valid for at least 3 months from the date you intend to enter Morocco. It should also have at least 1 blank page for passport stamps.

If your passport is due to expire before your trip, you must apply for a new passport then apply for your Morocco visa using the new document.

Note: Temporary passports are not accepted.

If you're applying with a residence permit from an eligible country, it must be valid for at least 180 days.

If you have a visa from an eligible country, it must be valid for at least 90 days from the date you intend to arrive in Morocco

For your visa to be approved, your photo must meet requirements:

4cm x 5cm or 3cm x 4cm	Taken in the last 6 months	Not show glares or camera flashes
Vertically aligned	Show facial features clearly	No sunglasses or hats

How to Apply for a Morocco Visa not online?

You must apply for a Morocco visa at a Moroccan diplomatic mission in your country. The exact application process changes depending on your country and the Moroccan representative office. However, it can be summed up as follows:

1. Make an appointment at the Morocco consulate or embassy.
2. Complete the Morocco visa application form.
3. Gather the required documents.
4. Submit them at the Moroccan embassy or consulate.
5. Pay the visa fee.
6. Wait for the Morocco visa to be processed.
7. Get the visa.

Citizens of the following countries do not need a visa for Morocco, but they must have an Electronic Travel Authorization
